



TIPS FOR CARPET EXTRACTION PRESPRAYS

HOW TO GET THE BEST RESULTS WITH OUR NEW IMPROVED SK50

There are some facts which it is helpful to remember:

1. The new SK50 will do everything the old formula did and in most cases do it a lot better.
2. It is now safe on all fibres including wool and 5th generation nylon. The pH of SK50 concentrate is now a maximum of 9.8 and this reduces further on dilution.
3. The oil and grease emulsifying ability of SK50 has been increased by a factor of 4. Certainly no need to pay for added emulsifier. It's soil suspending power is equal to the considerable ability of the original formula.

So it is an excellent stand alone carpet extraction prespray for most applications, and we have fully compatible additional products to enhance its action in a few special cases.

Example:

If you have heavy organic (animal & vegetable) contamination such as a filthy food serving area, the addition of enzyme is always helpful. It is important to allow a minimum of 15 minutes digestion time for the prespray.

For conventional sprayers backpacks etc.	For venturi type sprayers such as Sonitron® presprayer dilutes 1 to 8
500mls SK50 <u>125mls</u> Sonizyme Liquid in <u>10 litres</u> of water	1650mls SK50 <u>500mls</u> Sonizyme Liquid in <u>5 litre</u> reservoir

This combination has significant deodorant power, as well as high level cleaning ability.

When blending chemicals an important rule is to never mix concentrates. Always ensure that at least one part has water added before mixing. Also it is preferable to mix and apply immediately rather than let the mixture stand.
