

HOW TO KEEP YOUR CARPET & UPHOLSTERY LOOKING NEW.

1. *Attend to Spots and Stains as soon as you can.*
2. *Vacuum your carpet & upholstery with a good vacuum cleaner at least once a week.*
3. *Place a matting system at your doorways this will save wear and tear on your carpets. Your Professional Carpet Cleaning Technician will be able to advise you on the best type of matting to suit your needs.*
4. *Have your carpet & upholstery professionally cleaned on a regular basis. At least once every 12-18 months. If you have small children and/or animals you may need to have it cleaned more frequently. Discuss this with your Professional Carpet Cleaning Technician.*

How do I treat my spots & stains?



CARPET

1. Remove any soiling you can from the carpet.
2. Spray Zenith Encap Spot & Stain Remover lightly onto damaged area.
3. Blot the area with a white absorbent cloth, microfibre cloth or tissue. Absorb the stain into your cloth never rub and be careful not to spread and leave a ring. Absorb until you have the area as dry as you can. If necessary repeat again. Zenith Encap Spot & Stain Remover will give you a rapid dry.
4. Vacuum when dry to remove any Spot & Stain Remover residue



UPHOLSTERY

1. Remove any soiling you can from the upholstery
2. Before starting to remove stain pretest to make sure you can clean the fabric. Do this in an area which will not be seen. Wait until the area dries and make sure there is no dye run or change in appearance.
3. If there are no problems as in item 2. Blot the area with a white absorbent cloth, microfibre cloth or tissue. Absorb until the area is as dry as you can make it. Be very careful you treat the fabric as gently as you can.
4. Consider having your upholstery treated with "Brolly® Fabric Protector to provide extra protection. Ask your Professional Carpet Technician about this. Brolly is a registered trade mark of Sonitron® Australasia Pty.Ltd. copyright

Following the advice set out in this leaflet will help you to extend the life of your carpet and upholstery.

Remember that some stains such as hair dye, bleach spills may not be removed.

If you have any spills which are proving to be difficult to remove, call in your Professional Carpet Cleaning Technician. He will have the expertise to advise you on your options.
